National Child Care Provider Appreciation Day

Child care organizations and parents across the globe are joining together the Friday before Mother's Day, May 7, to celebrate Provider Appreciation Day.

Provider Appreciation Day is a special day to recognize child care providers, teachers, school-age program staff, child care center directors and staff, and all those who work with children and are responsible for their education and care. It is estimated that there are nearly 2.8 million child care providers in the United States and that more than 11 million children younger than age 5 are in their care.

"By applauding the dedication of child care providers on May 7, we remind our communities of the importance of high-quality child care, and let providers everywhere know that we recognize and value their important work," said Linda K. Smith, executive director of the National Association of Child Care Resource & Referral Agencies, the host organization of Provider Appreciation Day. "It is important that the care a child receives during the first five years of life be of high-quality because approximately 90 percent of brain development occurs during those years."
